ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

- Must attend orienation and complete registration forms
- Take a pretest to determine educational functioning level
- Provide a Photo Identification card (TX Driver's License or Identification, Passport, etc.)
- Provide social security number
- Must be 18 years or older and not attending high school. *Additional requirements for 16 & 17 years old
