Legislators should oppose any state voucher plan, tax credit, taxpayer savings grant, or tuition reimbursements to private institutions, homeschool students, or parent unless the recipient is held to the same financial and academic transparency, testing, and accountability requirements as public schools.

THOROUGHLY ANALYZE THE BENEFITS AND COSTS

and commit to adequately funding the mandate before passing any legislation.

REDUCE STATE TESTING

to that of the federal requirements. Additionally, tests should be shortened to include only those learning objectives that are essential for each grade level.
