

Eligible Rider Form

School buses shall be considered an extension of the classroom and students are expected to conduct themselves accordingly. Students being transported in school-owned vehicles shall comply with the **Student Code of Conduct**. Should the rules be broken, the following consequences will be invoked.

- <u>"A Note from the Bus Driver":</u> This note will be issued to inform you of your child's behavior during bus transportation times. The note will indicate the violation/concern, & a brief detailing of the occurrence. (All notes sent home by your child's bus driver will be logged but will not reflect your child's official school record. Reports will be based upon the & severity of the violation per discretion of the bus-driver)
- 2. **First Bus Conduct Report:** The student will then have a conference with the principal, or designee, and/or other disciplinary action may be taken. The student may retain bus privileges contingent upon not receiving another bus report.
- 3. <u>Second Bus Conduct Report</u>: If the student receives a second bus report within the same semester (or within a short space of time), he/she loses bus privileges for up to five days.
- 4. <u>Third Bus Conduct Report</u>: The student may lose bus privileges for up to 10 days.
- 5. <u>Fourth Bus Conduct Report</u>: The student may lose bus privileges for the remainder of the semester. After returning to the bus in the second semester, if the student receives another bus report, he/she will lose bus privileges for the remainder of the school year. In each instance the parents will be notified.

"ROAR ON THE BUS" (The 5 Rules):

- 1. Follow Directions of the Bus Driver
- 2. Speak Appropriately
- 3. Sit in your Seat Appropriately
- 4. Talk in a Quiet Voice
- 5. Keep the Bus Clean

Expectations of All Student Riders:

- 1. All Riders are expected to board and exit bus at their designated pick-up areas. Unless otherwise a written request is submitted by parent, & approved by Campus/Transportation dept. All changes will be handled through the campus office.
- 2. All riders are expected to be at their designated stops **5 minutes prior** to pick-up time.
- 3. All Parents/Guardians & Student Riders are expected to thoroughly read, acknowledge, sign, date & turn in the "Eligible Rider Acknowledgment Form" attached to this "Expectation of All Student Riders Form", which is also located at the back of the "Student Handbook" & in the "Student Enrollment Packet" within the first week of riding. Failure to return this form may result in loss of riding privileges.

- <u>4</u> <u>Third Bus Conduct Report</u>: The student may lose bus privileges for up to 10 days.
- 5 Fourth Bus Conduct Report: The student may lose bus privileges for the remainder of the semester. After returning to the bus in the second semester, if the student receives another bus report, he/she will lose bus privileges for the remainder of the school year. In each instance the parents will be notified.

Return this form to the driver or campus to establish driver eligibility within 5 days.
